In order to maximize the time we have left this year, the BIS Secondary Campus Term 3 CCA Programme will be launched on Monday 10th May 2021 with an extensive range of CCAs to choose from each week. As we enter the final term of 2020-21, this is the perfect opportunity to try something new or different!

With club activities centering around the three key elements of creativity, activity and service, we encourage students to explore each of these areas by making a broad choice of clubs. There are again many musical options where students can express their creativity by joining the Big Band, Rock Bands, the Chamber Orchestra, the Concert Band, Conducting Club, Brass or String Ensembles, or one of the many Choirs and Vocal Groups. In addition the Music Department will continue with the popular Music Technology Club for those students interested in music recording, how to work on a DAW (Logic ProX) and mixing techniques, recording and microphone techniques, synthesis and sampling.

A fabulous new club is on offer for those who enjoy developing their creativity through the sciences; Amazing Science Club promotes the love of science and scientific language. Or, you may prefer the Biology or the Science Experiment Club. The Creative Maths club is available to maths enthusiasts especially those interested in events such as SEAMC. For the artistic, there is **Prop Making** and **Digital Art** or why not **Design and Make your own Mini-Golf Course** working with DT equipment. Another fabulous new club; Create to Care is for those who love art and would like to use their skills to create sellable pieces and handmade products to raise funds for one of our community partners.

The Cross-Campus Student Leadership clubs will continue, offering students the opportunity to lead weekly activities aimed at enriching the Junior Campus and Early Years & Infant Campus CCA programme, and for senior students to mentor their younger peers and gain IBDP CAS experience.

Whether you enjoy art, music, drama, sport, languages, solving mathematical or scientific problems, helping disadvantaged groups or simply having fun and playing board games, there should be a club available for you.

#### **Paid Activities**

In addition to a large selection of free sporting activities such as Recreational Tag Rugby, Basketball, Football and Swimming, there are a number of paid activities that students can sign up for including RSFA Football and Volleyball, PJ Tennis, Vertical Academy Rock Climbing, SheWill be Strong Self Defence and Cheerleading as well as many others. These are provided by external individuals and organisations and all information is available in the online activities booklet.

If a student has selected a paid activity, an email confirming their choice will be sent to both the student and their parents. The payment deadline for all paid clubs is Friday 16th April 2021.

CCAs may run before lessons and during lunchtimes, however, the majority are scheduled after lessons.

There are two sessions each afternoon with a five-minute change-over period (2:50pm – 3:50pm and 3:55pm – 4:55pm). If activities finish beyond these times information is detailed in the booklet.

Note: Any students participating in CCAs from 3:55pm will need to arrange their own transport home and should consider this before selection.

#### **CAS at BIS**

Originating from the International Baccalaureate Programme they set out to challenge our students to show initiative and perseverance as well as to develop skills such as collaboration, problem solving and decision making. For a balanced experience, we encourage students to take part in at least one of each of the three areas below:

- Creativity: The arts, music, languages and other experiences that involve creative thinking.
- Activity: Physical exertion contributing to a healthy lifestyle.
- Any collaborative and reciprocal community engagement in response to an authentic need. • Service:

#### On-line CCA Selection - using CHQ

Activities need to be selected using the online CHO system. Please see the next page for further instructions.

You will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line CHQ homepage. Both the student and their parents will also receive notification when accepted for participation in an CCA.

For the majority of CCAs, the online system (CHQ) will randomly allocate students to each CCA. As it is not a first come first served system, you may not always get your first choice activity.

There are some exceptions to this rule as detailed below:

#### **Sports**

If the number of students for any sports activity is greater than the maximum capacity, students will undergo a trial and be notified of this during their first session. This may mean that you could initially be accepted for the CCA but possibly removed after the trial.

The PE department will endeavour to run a parallel programme during the same session for the same age group but in the form of a recreational club. Therefore, if a student has a poor trial or significantly improves their skill level, then the squad coach will be able to assess the student and potentially accept them into the squad at a later time.

#### Please note that:

· As competitive Sport runs as seasons and not terms (Sep - Nov, Nov - Feb, Feb - May and then May-June), some of the clubs which have started in September will stop in November whilst others may start in November and span over into Term 2.

#### Drama

Please note that you are not able to join school productions this term as they have already been cast, but if you are interested in getting involved in Drama then please speak to your Drama teacher about other opportunities.

#### How to select your activities/paid clubs:

- Step 1: From the Home Page under My Activities 2020-2021 Term 3 click View/Manage/Submit Activity Choices
- **Step 2**: For each activity/paid club add a different number e.g. Monday: Football club **add 1**, Wednesday: Board Games **add 2** then **3**, **4**, **5** etc. to all other clubs you would like to participate in.
- The **SAVE** button will appear to the right of the activity list click **SAVE**
- **Step 3**: Once you're happy with your choices you **MUST** press the **SUBMIT** button at the top of the page. You will receive an automated email confirming your club preferences.
- Step 4: To cancel a selection after submitting add a 0 to the desired box then save and submit
- **Step 5**: From the Home Page **My Activities 2020-2021 Term 3** you will be able to see which clubs you have been accepted into/denied from by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021. If you click onto **My Schedule** for week beginning Monday 10th May 2021, you can check your weekly club timetable.
