Just a quick note to send you the <u>School Lunch Menu for 27 October to 28 November</u>. The whole kitchen is being upgraded over the Mid-Term Break so that <u>we can offer hot and cold lunches</u> as well as pastries and fruit.

If you would like to order from the School Cafeteria, please note that <u>Year 1, 2 and 3 must</u> <u>order and pay in advance</u> as we collect all their meals for them. For <u>years 4 to 7, the children can choose each day</u> what they would like to eat and <u>pay</u> <u>with their Octopus</u> card. It's a good idea to pin the school menu on the fridge at home so that you can see if you like the meal choices for the week ahead!
