## Messages

- The FOBISIA maths challenge will be held at BISS Puxi on 5 and 6 March. All the children in Key Stage 1, 2 and 3 will be competing in their own maths challenge against all the other children in FOBISIA. Until 7 March, your child will be able to improve their maths knowledge, and practise for this challenge. All students have been given their log-in details for the Mathletics website, but please ask if they need a reminder.

#### Literacy

We will continue our topic creating a balanced argument. The children will be asked to write their own balanced argument on a topic of their choice. This will lead to the children developing their composition skills as they arrange their own opinions into relevant paragraphs. They will then use this model to have a formal debate in class at the end of the week.

#### Maths

Our focus will be on measures. We will be learning to convert from one metric unit of measure to another, making connections between similar uses of language such as kilometre, millimetre and centimetre. We shall work with problem solving activities, designed to consolidate understanding of metric measure and extend thinking skills. Our calculations will focus on using decimal notation with measures and this will be introduced in the context of money.

#### Themed Learning

#### Active Planet

We will use the maps we created last week as a stimulus to answer the question; "Should people live on fault lines? Will then research different fault lines around the world and find

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out about the different types of cultures that live upon the fault lines and what type of buildings they have built to cope with the threat of an Earthquake. The information we collect will be used in the following weeks Literacy when we write a balanced argument about people living on fault lines.

#### **PSHCE**

The children will be learning about poverty in relation to the secondary school project in Tanzania.

### Vocabulary

**Literacy** – for, against, pros, cons, discussion, debate, justification

**Maths** – millimetre, kilometre, centimetre, metre, gram, litre, pounds, penny, coin, note, convert, place value

Humanities - fault lines, tremor, Richter scale
