## Arabic

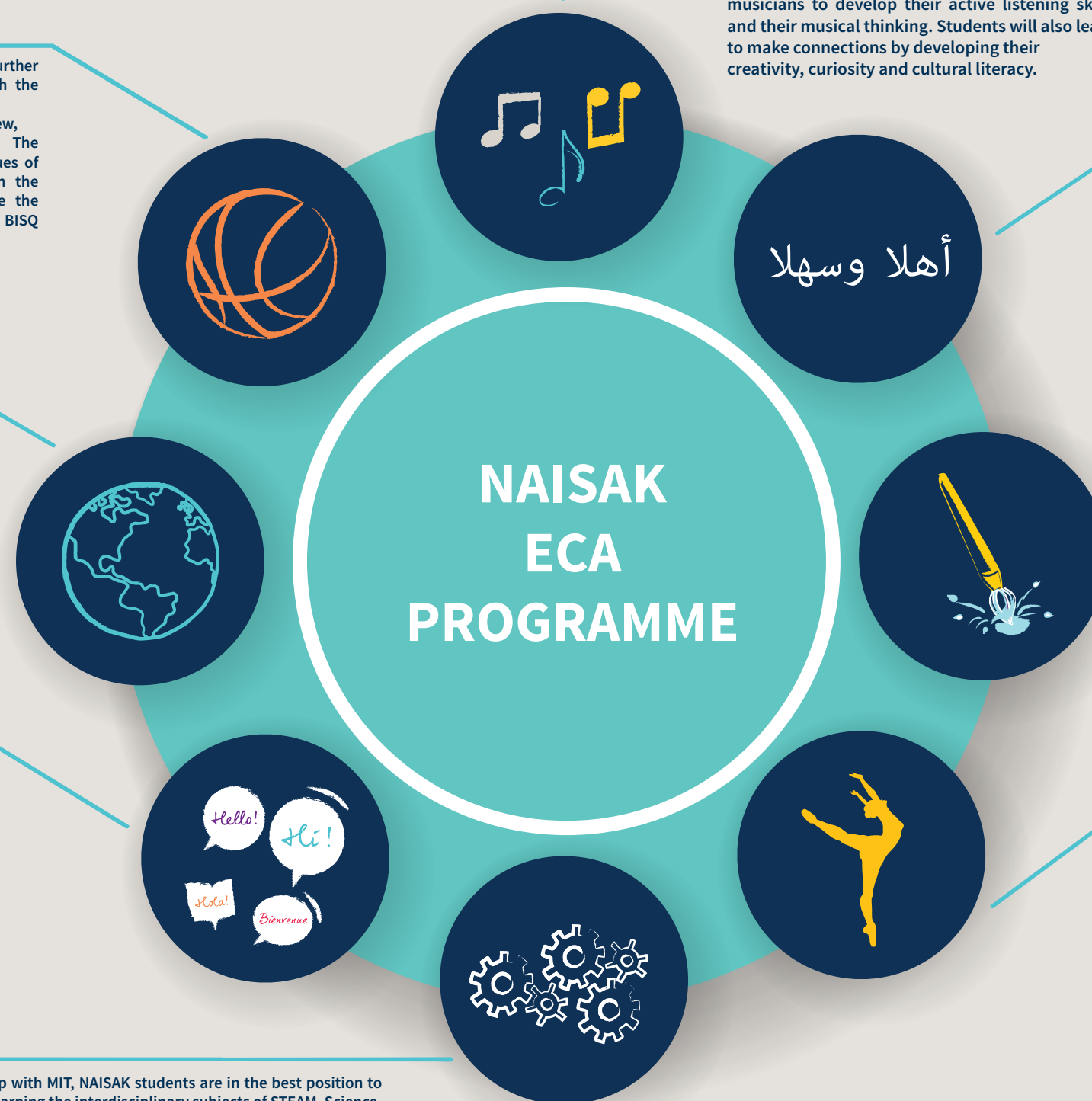
