A friend will accept you for who you are.


The more friends you have the better.

Friends always stand up for each other.


If your friend is being unkind to someone, you should take their side.

Avoids looking at people	Makes eye contact	Glares or stares
Gives in	Negotiates or compromises	Forces their decisions

I is for "I" statements

Say how you feel and what you need, not what they did.

"Hey! You took the ball! That's not fair!"

"I am feeling left out. I would really like a turn. Please can I go next?"

"You ruined my picture! I'm telling on you!"

"I am really sad my picture got damaged. I worked hard on it. I need help to fix it."

"Stop chasing me! Go away!"

"I want to be on my own just now. I need some space."

R is for Respect


