Registration and Fees

Please click the link to the registration Jotform. As soon as you have submitted your registration, we will start the process of allocating a teacher and arranging a timetable for your child. The total cost of lessons is RMB 2,000 for ten thirty minute lessons per term. In order to book individual instrument lessons all fees must be paid in full within two weeks of registration.

Fees are payable to the activities administrator, Ms Olivia Zhang (o-zhang@naispudong.com) who is located in the office opposite the main reception.

Lessons will be scheduled on a rotational basis. Your child's timetable will be emailed to you by the instrumental instructor and is posted in the Performing Arts Centre. Classroom teachers for students in Years 1-6 will also receive a copy of the timetable.

Attendance

If you know in advance that your child is going to be absent, please inform me as well as the instrumental teacher the day before a scheduled lesson or earlier. If your child is absent from school due to illness, please notify me so that I can inform the relevant teachers. Lessons missed due to compulsory school activities and teacher absence will be made up by the teacher concerned.

We reserve the right to charge for lessons which have been missed where this has not been communicated in a reasonable manner.

Equipment

Students must bring their Music Learning Journals and music scores to all lessons. Students should also bring their academic learning journals so that the teacher concerned can assist in monitoring potential clashes with class tests and assessments.

Instruments

This year, the school has a range of Brass and Woodwind instruments that students can use free of charge. Instruments will be issued on a first-come first-served basis and can be used for up to two full terms.

Thereafter, parents and pupils will be requested to acquire their own instrument. Pianos and drum kits are not available.

Borrowed instrument must be returned in the same condition as they were borrowed, barring normal usage wear and tear. In the event of loss or damage, the borrower will fund the replacement of instrument of equal value, or at list price for an instrument of this model and make.

General

All lessons take place in the Performing Arts Centre on the first floor in the individual music practice rooms. Students are expected to leave their regular lessons five minutes before their scheduled time so that they are able to receive their full lesson allocation.

In order to make adequate progress, it is strongly recommended that students practise their instrument for a minimum of twenty minutes per day.


Parents are encouraged to organise suitable practice times as part of their child's regular homework routine.
