RE: SCHOOLTRACKER AND INFORMATION ON SHANGHAI DISRUPTION

Dear Parents /Guardians,

I am happy to enclose your child's fifth tracker of this academic year. As we head towards the end of the school year I hope that this is further evidence of the hard work that your child is putting in: learning new skills and facts about the world around us. There is still time to improve over the next few weeks before the end of year exams and the final reports that will be issued in June. The dates for these exams are 2 – 6 June. Please expect a further letter from the relevant heads of Key Stages about ways of supporting your child during the revision process.

In the meantime if you have any questions or queries relating to the tracker there are three options that you can take. The first option is to contact your child's form tutor who can help clarify some questions or give you more information on any patterns of behaviour that you notice across a number of different subjects. You can also contact a teacher directly with subject specific questions and will find their details on the tracker. Alternatively, you can contact a Head of Faculty or Department for more information regarding your child's progress within their subject.

Shanghai Disruption 20 and 21 May
