

Literacy

This week in literacy we will be looking at comic / cartoon strips. Here the children will be looking at the different features of comics / cartoon strips and will then produce their own. This is all linked in with our themed learning as we continue to explore the different ways that people present stories. If you have any old comic books, please feel free to bring them in to share with the children.

Phonics

This week in phonics the children will be studying the following sounds or phases:

Stingrays: aw, wh, ph, ew

Starfish: alternative pronunciations of i

Jellyfish: oa and or

Octopus: revisiting previously taught alternative sounds

Sharks: adding s and es

Pufferfish: their, there and they're and the oo sound

Maths

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This week the children will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes. Here we will be identifying and naming key shapes and looking at their properties. Such as: How many sides does a square have? Can you name a shape that has 3 vertices? The children will also be looking at symmetry within 2D shapes and they will create their own symmetrical patterns.

Themed Learning - The Stories People Tell

Over the course of this topic we will share legends and myths from around the world with the children. The children will look at the origin of the story and compare legends from different countries. The children will use their skills in Digital Literacy to research a story and then present it in a PowerPoint. Art activities will focus on 3D skills and textiles as we look at art as a means of telling stories through different mediums, e.g. masks, plates, Greek pots and dream catchers.

In unison with this topic, we will look at sound waves in Science and coding skills in Computer Science.

Vocabulary

Literacy – comic, cartoon, onomatopoeia, bold, though bubble, speech bubbles

Maths- 2d, 3d, flat, fat, vertices, sides, faces, corners, roll, stack, symmetrical, patterns

Humanities – myth, legend, story, hero, research, textiles, sound waves, coding.

Computing Science- keyboard, input, code, app, instruction, log on, log off, control, enter
