We started the academic year reflecting on "perseverance" in our first Primary Years assembly and Lieze has certainly demonstrated her ability to persevere through participating in another Global Campus opportunity seen here: Rube Goldberg Challenges.

Ms Sophie (Year 4 Hummingbirds), Mr Gerald (Year 5 Kestrels) and Mr Alf (Year 6/7 Eagles) have all been working hard to encourage our older students to engage more independently with the Global Campus platform.

One of the STEAM activities for students to develop their ability to persist with a task was to build a Rube Goldberg machine. The children were encouraged to use a brief planning document but for the majority for them, it was trial and error - another important skill to employ in STEAM learning.

Lieze impressed her teachers with her level of determination in carrying out thirty attempts before her machine was successful. Overall, our students enjoyed the challenge as it is different to what they would normally be asked to do, plus it has certainly encouraged them to engage with Global Campus.

Batik Day




