In *Literacy*, we will continue working on improving our comprehension skills. We will also revisit the past tense and also explore magazine articles in the build up to writing our own.

In *Numeracy*, we will be learning about geometric shapes and lines as well as different types of angles.

In *Science*, we will be learning about ways that human activity affects the environment.

Our IPC topic is 'Olympics.' We will be creating our own artistic gymnastics routine with hoops, balls and bean bags.

In Art, we will be using clay to recreate the designs of Greek Plates, which we designed in the previous lessons.

In ICT, we will be making links to our Science topic 'Habitats' and creating PowerPoints about various animals and their habitats.

In PSHE, we will be continuing our new topic of 'Healthy Me.' A couple of weeks ago we started discussing what is healthy and what are some healthy habits we should. This week we will continue with these discussions and further explore being healthy.
