## Starters: Reading



Read a paragraph of a story. What picture could you draw that summarises the paragraph? What is going on in this part of the story?



Write some interview questions you would like ask the main character of your story.



Write a paragraph from a different perspective of another character in your story.



Read a Greek myth and make a note of all the literary features that is used- are there any similes, onomatopoeia words or metaphors?
