

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for <u>next</u> <u>week</u>.

In *Literacy*, we are learning the key features of different text types, along with completing Cambridge Revision sessions.

In *Numeracy*, we will be beginning our preparation for the upcoming Cambridge assessments by going over past papers from previous years. We will also be focusing on equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

In *Science,* we will be continuing our Cambridge revision, looking at past papers and effective strategies to answer assessment questions.

Our IPC we will be focusing on our Exit Point for our current topic. We will be designing and creating our own exhibition on technologies of the future.

In ICT, we are learning to add voice sounds to enhance an animated story. We will learn to record our own voice sounds, insert blocks to play the recordings and match the timing of sounds with speech bubbles.

In **PSHE**, we are starting our new jigsaw piece: Healthy Me. We are learning the different food groups and how to have a healthy, balanced diet.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
