This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **the week after the break.**

In **Literacy**, we will begin to focus on persuasive writing and students will write their own persuasive letter.

In **Numeracy**, we will be learning to round decimal numbers to the next whole number.

In **Science**, we will start our new topic 'Sound.' We will look at some instruments and think about how sound is made and how it travels before briefly looking at noise pollution. We will also carry out some investigations to study how sound travels.

Our **IPC** topic is 'Active Planet.' For our entry point, we will be designing a Disaster Relief Centre where we will need to consider how to keep people safe and what they will need in the event of an earthquake.

In **Art**, we will be recreating the picture 'The Great Wave' by Katsushika Hokusai.

In **ICT**, we will be researching Volcanoes from around the world and will present this information using Microsoft word or PowerPoint.

In **PSHE**, we will be continuing our new topic of 'Healthy Me'.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists on Wednesday and will be tested on the list the following Wednesday. Students will have 9 or 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
