

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next</u> <u>week</u>**.

In *Literacy*, we will be planning and then writing a letter of explanation. We will be exploring the use of flashbacks in writing and learning how to introduce and write flashbacks.

In *Numeracy*, we will be revising different methods for adding and subtracting up to 5-digit numbers. This will include using a number line and column method. Children must remember to carry over numbers correctly when subtracting.

In *Science*, we will be looking at the process of the water cycle. We will identify the 4 processes, and show how each one affects the water cycle. KEY WORDS: Evaporation, Condensation, Precipitation, Collection.

In **IPC**, we will be finishing off their Egyptian Hieroglyphics, continuing to explore art through a range of styles and materials. We will then be researching ideas about what pottery structure we would like to create and then we will be making our pottery out of clay.

In ICT, students will be using the app Sketch Up to continue creating their art galleries. They will continue to input their artwork and change the design of their walls, ceiling and floors.

In **PSHE**, we will be continuing to focus on Global Warming. We will be researching different aspects of Global Warming and seeing what we can do to prevent it. The children will be preparing to present to the rest of the class.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists every week and will be tested on the list on the same day, the following week. Please see student's timetables to see when they have spellings. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
