**RE: TRANSITION DAY – FRIDAY 12 JUNE**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am writing to inform you that this year's Transition Day will be held in our Secondary Campus on Friday 12 June. This is a valuable opportunity for your son/daughter to experience school life as a secondary student, before they join us as a student in Year 7 in August.

In order to ensure the day runs smoothly, each Year 6 class will be escorted around the secondary school by a group of reliable Year 7 students. These students will also be visiting the primary campus to deliver a settling in assembly on 10 June, so your son/daughter's class will know exactly who they are.

On the morning of the 12 June, Year 6 students should go to their normal classroom on the primary campus. They will be met by their Year 7 students and taken directly to the secondary Sports Hall, where the whole year group will begin the day with team building activities. To ensure a quick start to the day, we ask that students come into school in their PE kits. It is therefore important that students pack their school uniform in a bag, ready to change after the first session.

The rest of the day will be spent in classes attending four lessons across the school. These lessons depend on what Year 6 class your son/daughter is in, but a variety of exciting experiences are guaranteed. Students will then return to the primary campus at around 3:15pm, ready to return home as normal.
