## **Monday schedule of activities**

<b>Activity</b>	<b>Venue</b>	<b>Brief Description of the ECA</b>
Yr 1 - 2 Board Games	Room 76	Play a variety of simple card games and board games e.g. snap, snakes and ladders etc. t aimed at teaching children how to play together, developing social skills, such as taking turns, winning and losing gracefully.
Year 1 Construction	Room 77	Use a variety of construction equipment to design and create purpose built structures.
Year 2 Construction	Room 31a	Use a variety of construction equipment to design and create purpose built structures .
Yr 1 – 2 Playground Games	Room 23 and FS2 Play area	Playground games provide children with opportunities to develop in a range of areas including; social, physical and communicational skills. Take part in parachute, skipping ropes, ball games and circle games.
Year 1 – 2 Math's Club	Room 31	Fun math games to develop children's confidence in this area of their learning.
Year 1-2 Animal Art Club	Room 61	Learn how to develop drawing skills whilst experimenting with techniques in art design and textiles. A great ECA for the children keen on art.
Year 2 Japanese Club	Room 14	Study both traditional and modern aspects of Japan, its rich and interesting culture and of course language. The sessions will provide opportunities for making sushi, origami, learning traditional Japanese stories.  <b>Restricted to Year 2 children as this group will join the Year 3 students</b>
Yr 1 – 2 Textiles Club	Room 81	Children will make various items using textiles based on a variety of themes.
Year 1-2 Irish Ceilil Dancing	Shed 1	Learn the individual steps to this dance before putting it all together to form a dance known as the Siege of Ennis, followed by the dance the Walls of Limerick.

Yr 2 Hand Sewing and Embroidery	Room 26	Learn basic hand sewing techniques. Create personalized bookmarks and pillowcases and develop skills to work on larger projects such as finger puppets.  <b>Restricted to Year 2</b>
Year 2 Using iPads for Film Making	Room 84	Work together to produce a short film on a chosen text. Learn to use props, voices, acting and music through an app which will facilitate the short film.  <b>Restricted to Year 2</b>
Yr 1 – 2 ICT Club	Primary ICT Club	Learn to master skills necessary to use a range of valuable word processing and presenting tools such as Power Point, Word, Publisher and Paint. Learn the important skills of touch typing through a range of activities and games
Year 1-2 Drama Club	Room 17	Have the opportunity to engage in a range of creative and imaginative role play situations
Year 2 Creative Art Club	Room 72	Learn how to develop their drawing skills and in addition experiment with techniques in art design and textiles. A great ECA for the children keen on art.  <b>Restricted to Year 2</b>
Year 1 Art & Craft Club	Room 79	Learn to develop a range of artistic skills using different materials and techniques. Children to work on creating a final piece based on a chosen topic by the group, which the children will take home.  <b>Restricted to Year 1</b>
Yr 1 – 2 Dance Fit	Shed 1	Dance fit encourages children to focus on movement and expression through dance and fitness. The children will have the opportunity to learn routines and make up their own to perform to others.
Yr 1 – 2 French Club	Room 105	In This ECA the students will be learning about France and the French language through games and songs. It is a great ECA for students who are interested in languages.
