Literacy

The focus of the week is providing students the opportunity to have access to previous SATs papers. This will allow students to consider what they need to develop and improve upon in their learning.

Themed Learning

Students will investigate forces including gravity, up thrust, water resistance, friction and gravity. They will design an investigation which will explain their understanding which will be filmed and entered into a competition with other international schools.
