We have several children at each phase of the school with severe nut allergies (life threatening) that can be triggered just by coming into contact with nuts or nut traces in foods. Literacy

This week we will begin our new topic of 'Stories from Different Cultures'. We are going to examine different versions of the traditional tale 'Cinderella' examining similarities and differences in the narratives.

Maths

All students will be working on traditional methods of multiplication and looking at inverse operations while some students will extend their tasks to include the multiplication of decimals.

Themed Learning

'Building a Village

This week we will continue our topic 'Building a Village'. Students will be investigating geographical terminology and identifying how villages are formed based on different uses of buildings.

Science

Some students will be working on Science this week. They will be investigating how to make bread by investigating yeast under different conditions.

Computing

Some students will begin using the 'Blender' software to design their village ready to make it out of clay during the second half of the term. They will be using a variety of skills including digital modeling.

PSHCE

In PSHCE this term we will be looking at team work and collaborative working. We will focus further on fostering new relationships, creating rules and expectations for the group and how to work together successfully.

We have been looking at describing animals. Homework is to describe an animal of their choice using a range of adjectives for colour, size and appearance ensuring adjective agreement.

Year 5 French - Mrs Rae

Pupils continued to work on clothing. Homework is to find a picture of a celebrity (famous person) on the internet and print it out or in a magazine and stick it on some paper. Describe what the celebrity is wearing, include an opinion.

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Year 5 French - Mme McConnon

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The new beginners have focused on talking about sports they like and dislike and giving a positive reason for their opinion. They learnt colours and taught these to the rest of the class. Other students created board games to review the language learnt last term. Homework for all is to learn colours through games on linguascope, to complete the colours worksheet and finish off the boardgames.
