Re: Year 1 Visit to Shanghai History Museum–Thursday 5 March and Friday 6 March

Year 1 will be going on an exciting educational visit to the Shanghai History Museum. This visit is connected to our Themed Learning unit, All Dressed Up. This will be a great opportunity for the children to further develop their knowledge of what Shanghai was like in the past, what clothes people used to wear and how these were made.

- **Classes 1I and 1X** will attend the trip on **Thursday 5 March**
- **Classes 1B, 1S and 1P** will attend on **Friday 6 March**
- We will be leaving school at approximately 9.00am and returning to school in the afternoon in time for the usual end of day arrangements. We will travel by private school bus and ensure that children are wearing seat belts.
- Students who normally have school lunch will be provided with a packed lunch on the day. All other students will need to provide their own lunch. You may pack an additional drink and small healthy (nut-free) snack should you wish to.
- Students will be required to wear uniform as normal on the day, but should wear comfortable walking shoes and a jacket.
- We would like two parent volunteers from each class to support us on this day. Please let us know if you would like to volunteer.
