




#### Singapore Red Cross Society

The work of the Red Cross in Singapore began on 30 September 1949 as a branch of the British Red Cross. On 6 April 1973, it was incorporated by an Act of Parliament and became known as the Singapore Red Cross (SRC).

Their vast network of donors, volunteers, employees and partners contribute to their lifesaving mission by serving in the following services and programs: Community FirstAid, TransportAid, Red Cross Home for the Disabled and others.

Our children arrive emotionally, spiritually, and sometimes physically, bruised, but with love we see changes quickly. We ensure every child within our care has access to education and health care. To supplement their education, and to provide a



creative outlet, we have musical instruments in the houses (keyboard, guitar, drums...) and lots of arts and crafts opportunities! We also have several children who we sponsor to live with extended families in their local community. To fulfill another big need here we also run a small but growing nursery school for our young children and impoverished children in our local community. Finally, we have a chicken project for our sustainability, and we have a small microfinance programs for single mothers.

The children had to use their mental addition and subtraction skills to work out how much change to give to our customers. The students all had \$2 to spend and the option to give a separate donation.






# **11ML Valentine's Bake Sale**

11ML baked Valentine treats and opened up a shop in The Lounge. 11ML worked hard during the week to bake goods for the sale.


They set up and ran their sale by themselves, the staff and parents were invited to buy the goods.

The money raised went to The Red Cross Singapore and their work in the areas affected by Indonesian Flooding and Australian bush-fires.


