

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will begin studying persuasive writing. We will be examining persuasive texts, the language used and the structure of the texts. Towards the end of the week, we will then begin writing our own persuasive texts.

In **Numeracy**, we will be focusing on fractions. We are learning to convert mixed numbers into fractions, find a common denominator of fractions and add/subtract unit fractions with different denominators.

In **Science**, we will be investigating the relationship between force and energy and will explain what the key term 'work' means in a scientific context. We will also be looking at how magnets work and will explore the differences between magnetic and non-magnetic materials.

In **IPC** we will be creating posters advertising our 'NAISAK Miniature Fairground'. We will also be considering the opinions of others through a number of different debates. Following this, we will continue learning about the role of the Emir in Qatar.

In **ICT**, we will start looking at the Program 'Scratch'. We will be examining the features of Scratch, and looking to create our own maze.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at the word 'power', and what that means to us. We will be investigating how people may hold a certain power over others.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
