

# **OUR CURRICULUM**

We start in the primary school with Early Years, progressing through Key Stages 1 and 2. In the secondary school, specialist teaching programmes in Key Stages 3 and 4 develop deeper understanding across the arts, humanities, languages and sciences. Age 16, students sit examinations in up to 12 subjects earning IGCSE qualifications that are recognized worldwide. For their last two years, our students study for the International Baccalaureate Diploma.

Our Ambitions Based Learning approach to education means that the children and young people in our care will achieve highly at school and develop the character and way of thinking needed to succeed beyond school and university. Our students are encouraged to become diligent learners, excellent performers and inspiring leaders.



# WHERE DO OUR TEACHERS COME FROM?


The majority of our teachers come from the UK. We also have specialist and language teachers from France, Germany, Spain, China and the Middle East.



# STUDENTS IN OUR FAMILY OF SCHOOLS SHINE


Year on year our students continue to achieve outstanding results across our family of schools. In 2015 over 50% of all grades from all of our schools GCSE cohort were A\*A, more than double the world average of 21%.

25% of the same year's IB cohort achieved over 40 points, a globally acknowledged mark of true excellence, and 5 times the global figure of 5%.


# TO HELP YOUR CHILD THRIVE AND LEAD IN THE 21ST-CENTURY
