## Starters: Reading



Create a storyboard based on your favourite book. What happens in the different parts of the story?



Create a book review based on your favourite book. How many stars would you give this book out of 5 stars? Why should other people read this book?



Create a character booklet describing the characters from your favourite story. Make sure you include a picture of the characters. E.g. The dragon is greedy, fat and bossy. He has bright red scales and sharp, pointy spikes on his tail. He is used to getting his own way.

**Main Course** – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading- 3 times per week
- Spellings- see blue spelling book
- Times Tables
- Athletics
- Reading Eggs

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.
- Dessert projects are optional. If you have completed it, you will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
- If you are feeling *extra* hungry, you can order from the starters. Each dish has a difficulty rating. The more chilies, the more *challenging* the task!
- Why not spend some time tackling some of the family side dishes? Time spent as a family is important and you can learn together whilst having fun.
