The British School of Kuwait, under the direction and supervision of Cambridge International (CAIE) and Pearson Edexcel, is required to follow strict rules for the conduct of external examinations. All students have received a copy of the rules for candidates and have signed to agree to abide by them. These same rules will be applied to the Year 11 mock examinations to be held in December 2019 and January 2020.

All students have been provided with a mock examination timetable. This is also available on our website at <https://www.bsk.edu.kw/parent-essentials/examinations>.

Students must arrive at least 20 minutes prior to the start of each mock examination. Year 11 students may leave school during sessions when they do not have mock examinations, but only if one of their parents has signed the separate letter to grant permission for this.

Students have also been issued with an entry form for their May/June 2020 examinations. The deadline for students to return their entry form to the Examinations Officer, Mr Daniel Charlton, will be Thursday 23 January 2020. Students may make changes to their exam entries without penalty up until Tuesday 04 February 2020. If entry forms are submitted after this deadline, late fees will apply. Please note that entry forms will not be accepted if any school fees are outstanding.
