



Curriculum Synopsis

Listening:

Recognize common memorized words and expressions upon hearing them.

Reading:

Recognize a number of letters and vocalization markers, and some words and phrases he learned.

Writing:

Copy some familiar letters, words and phrases.

Speaking:

Communicate about a limited number of very familiar topics using single words or memorized expressions.
