We would really like to ask for your help with this by assisting your child/children to gather information, artefacts and anything that would bring the table to life. If you are willing to produce a dish or plate of food that is a taster from your country, please indicate this in the reply slip below. If you are willing to come into the school from 8am for a few hours to help with your country's table, please also indicate this. There is a tick list on the reply slip for you to indicate the areas you would be willing to help with. Once we have this information we will map out a programme for the day with exact requirements.
