Year 5 will be going on an exciting educational visit to Thames Town. As part of the visit, we will go to the Songjiang Urban Planning Exhibition. This visit is connected with our Themed Learning focus on 'Building a Village' and will be a great opportunity for children to further develop their knowledge of how settlements develop and what similarities they can observe between Thames Town as a modern construction and the villages they are familiar with.

This visit will take place on Tuesday 3 March 2015.
