Messages

- Please remember that Register time first thing in the morning is a very important time for teachers to welcome children into the classroom and to discuss the days lessons with them and to make sure all children know what BISCAP or ECAs they are attending that day. If you wish to communicate with your child's teacher please write a note in the Communication Book or send an email.
- Show and Tell To support our new Humanities topic (see below for details) we would like the children to bring in their favourite toy and be prepared to tell the class a little bit about it. Such as where they got it from, what they like about it in particular and how old they think it is.
- For the next two weeks the Maths homework across the Primary school will be to create a Maths Trail based on Shanghai. This is a great opportunity for the children to link maths to their local community and to encourage them to use their thinking skills. During Maths week children will then have the opportunity to try to solve the Maths Trails of the other children in their class.

Literacy

In Literacy, we will continue our theme of Fairy tales. We will be reading some more familiar fairy tales and talking about the characters and settings, using exciting vocabulary. We will sequence a familiar Fairy tale into beginning, middle and end and re-tell the story using appropriate Fairy tale language.

Phonics

Starfish – will be revising CCVCC words. For example, crust, blast, frost, think, spend. Pufferfish – Learning to spell and read tricky words Stringrays – sh and ch Octopuses – ew compared to oo Jellyfish – Continuing tri-graph review Sharks – Alternative pronunciation of er

Maths

In Maths this week we will be learning about Weight. We will revise the concepts of heavier and lighter. Then the children will use their skills of enquiry to first estimate and then measure the weight of different objects using balance scales and non-standard units, such as cubes.

Themed Learning

Themed Learning covers our Science, Humanities and Art sessions. Teachers will be adopting a themed learning approach on a weekly or biweekly basis to allow for a more creative, cross-curricular approach to learning. Teachers may highlight specific Science, Humanities and Art skills being covered each week, but generally will provide an overview for the learning block.

Science

Our Science topic this half term is Forces. Children will learn about different sorts of movement and how to describe these. They relate movement to pushes and pulls. The children will experiment with and investigate the effects that forces have on the world around them. They will

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make observations and communicate these findings to their peers and their teacher.

Humanities

In this unit children will look at similarities and differences between toys today and toys in the past. It introduces children to the concepts of 'old' and 'new', and encourages them to think about the changes that occur in their own lives and in those of their family or adults around them. The approach used in this unit could be applied to the study of other everyday things from the past, *eg clothes, games*. The children will have opportunities to develop their speaking and listening skills.

PSHCE

This term we will begin our topic on Relationships. This unit focuses specifically on feelings. It explores feelings within the context of our important relationships including family and friends. The theme aims to develop knowledge, understanding and skills in three social and emotional aspects of learning: self-awareness, managing feelings and empathy.

Art

In this unit the children will be transferring their knowledge of materials from our previous topic in Science to look at playground equipment. They will then design and make a piece of playground equipment using a variety of materials and joining, cutting and folding skills.
