

Curriculum Synopsis

The aim of this course is to introduce students to the Arabic language and to immerse them with the cultural aspect that would help them build their language proficiency. Grammar will be one of the learning focuses as it builds the accuracy of the written and the spoken speech.

For this term, we will be covering "My clothes", "weather and Seasons" and "Colors". By the end of the term your son /daughter will have the opportunity to build the language skills through a variety of learning outcomes, which are outlined in the curriculum brief of term 2.

Listening:

Understand simple words, expressions and sentences related to daily life. The listener can also understand limited information within an oral discourse, and the

Reading:

Understand familiar words, expressions and sentences in short simple texts related to daily life. The reader can understand some key information in such texts.

Writing:

Write short and simple texts and comments about familiar everyday topics.

Speaking:

Communicate and exchange information about familiar topics, using memorized or his own simple phrases and sentences. The speaker can usually interact in daily social situations using simple short questions and answers.
