In **Literacy**, we will be revisiting grammar concepts such as using commas to mark clauses, apostrophes as well as first and third person narrative.

In **Numeracy**, we will be learning to solve 2-step word problems, using addition and subtraction.

In **Science**, we will continue with our topic of 'Sound.' We will focus on 'pitch' (how high or low a sound is). If you have any empty tissue boxes these would be a great help for our lesson!

Our **IPC** topic is 'Active Planet.' We will be learning about famous Volcanoes from around the world and will have a go at locating them on a world map.
