In *Literacy*, we will be revisiting grammar concepts such as using commas to mark clauses, apostrophes as well as first and third person narrative.

In *Numeracy*, we will be learning to solve 2-step word problems, using addition and subtraction.

In *Science,* we will continue with our topic of 'Sound.' We will focus on 'pitch' (how high or low a sound is). If you have any empty tissue boxes these would be a great help for our lesson!

Our IPC topic is 'Active Planet.' We will be learning about famous Volcanoes from around the world and will have a go at locating them on a world map.

In Art, we will be carrying on with creating 'The Great Wave' image by artist Katsushika Hokusai

In ICT, we will be continuing to research volcanoes and other types of natural disasters using Microsoft Word or PowerPoint.

In **PSHE**, we will be starting our new topic of 'Relationships'. We will explore all the relationships we are a part of in our daily lives.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists on Wednesday and will be tested on the list the following Wednesday. Students will have 9 or 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
