Years 10 & 11 | IGCSE Programme

Years 10 and 11 students study for the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course examinations. IGCSE courses offer a mix of practical experience and theoretical knowledge and develop a range of core skills including teamwork and problem-solving.

All students study Mathematics, English, English Literature and at least one Science subject, and they choose from among the other subjects, usually following eight or nine IGCSE courses in total.

All students also attend Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) and Physical Education, and Thai students study Thai language and culture, as required by the Thai Ministry of Education.

Years 12 & 13 | International Baccalaureate® (IB) Diploma Programme (DP)

Students in Year 12 and Year 13 follow the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme (DP).

As well as studying six subjects - three at Higher Level and three at Standard Level - students must complete an Extended Essay, a Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course and a balanced Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) programme to gain their IB Diploma. Where appropriate, students may receive individual subject certificates in place of a full diploma.

IB Diploma Results 2021

45 points - Highest IB Pass Score achieved by a **Class of 2021 student**

20% of our students achieved 40+ points

35 points - Average IB Diploma points score (World Average = 33)

95% of our students who are in the IB programme achieve the IB Diploma compared to 89% in the world

We measure our students' progress by comparing their final IB scores against baseline prediction from internationally respected post-16 assessments.

St Andrews does not rank students or calculate GPA for students.

Disciplinary Infractions

St Andrews will report all suspensions and exclusions related to infractions that raise significant concerns about the academic integrity of an individual, or the safety/well-being of those around them.

COVID Disruption

During 2020 and 2021, campus closures due to local lockdowns meant that learning pivoted from in-school to online on a number of occasions, accounting for approximately 30% of term-time. Throughout all lockdowns, lessons continued to be delivered in a live online format, continuing to follow the original school timetable. This resulted in a minimal loss of learning-time. Assessment of students in their relative courses continued throughout each period of lockdown.

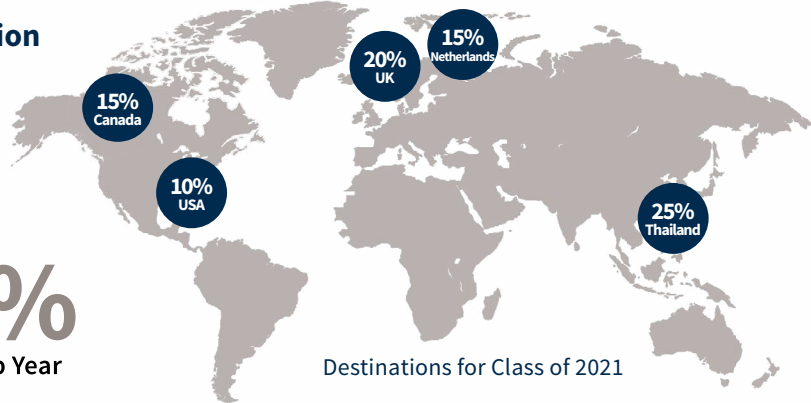
Between March 2020 and the end of 2021, the majority of local SAT administrations were cancelled as centres made individual decisions regarding the safety of testing during periods of lockdown. This resulted in most students not being able to obtain SAT scores.
