Literacy

In Literacy the children will be continuing with non-fiction. They will be using their knowledge of the features of non-fiction texts to research different dinosaurs to create their own two page non-chronological report on their favourite dinosaur. They will start by thinking about the type of information they need and planning their main sub titles; creating questions to answer in each section and then retrieving and recording what they have found out.

Maths

In Maths the children will be using their number facts, knowledge of place value and addition and subtraction to solve word problems. The children will work on their knowledge of the language of Maths to help them identify the type of sum they need, finding the important numbers and then connecting this to their previous learning

Themed Learning

Themed Learning covers our Science, Humanities, Art and PSHCE sessions. Teachers will be adopting a themed learning approach on a weekly or biweekly basis to allow for a more creative, cross-curricular approach to learning. Teachers may highlight specific

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Science, Humanities and Art skills being covered each week, but generally will provide an overview for the learning block.

'Footprints from the Past'

This week, the children will continue to research into what dinosaurs looked like and how we know to support their writing in Literacy. They will also develop their art skills further by experimenting with different materials to create repeating patterns.

PHSCE

The children will be focusing on sharing their views and opinions with others. They will work on listening to each other and taking in to consideration different viewpoints. We will also be working on recognising the positive in ourselves and each other and celebrating our achievements.

Vocabulary

Literacy –non-fiction, non-chronological report, introduction, title, conclusion, paragraph, title, subtitle, fact box, diagram, label, caption, information, retrieve, notetaking

Maths—add, addition, count on, more, plus, altogether, subtract, subtraction, minus, take away, leave, number line, calculation, problem solving, place value, units, tens, hundreds, digit

Themed Learning –print, technique, texture, line, dinosaur, predator, prey, food chain, diet, herbivore, carnivore, omnivore, reptile, mammal, fish, biped, quadruped, **PSHCE** –view, opinion, viewpoint, share, achievement, positive.
