In *Literacy*, we will continue exploring the key features of a magazine and will revisit using adverbs to describe verbs in our writing.

In *Numeracy*, we will be using division and multiplication facts to solve problems as well as add 4-digit numbers using various methods.

In *Science*, we will be further exploring Habitats and will learn how various animals adapt to their living environment.

Our IPC topic is 'Olympics.' We will be will be learning about the Paralympics and will have a go at playing some Paralympic sports.

In Art, we will be creating artwork based on the Olympic Rings.
