



Curriculum Synopsis

The curriculum of Islamic studies in year one focus on short Surahs, Hadiths and Anasheed which are all easily understood, and are age related. The Islamic studies lessons are taught in a fun atmosphere and through simple conversation whilst ensuring that the child is learning at their pace. Furthermore, it aims to give pupils a clear, thorough understanding of Islamic teachings, moral behavior and Islamic etiquette.

Some of the influential personalities in Islamic history are studied, such as the life of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH), role models, values and ethics. Moreover, student's skills in Tajweed are developed through reading the Holy Qur'an.

In this term we will cover the following topics:

- Etiquette at bedtime
He applies Islamic etiquette at bedtime.
- Surat An-Nas'
Applying the manners of recitation, and memorizes Surah of An-NAS
- Allah is the Creator
He discovers that Allah, glory be to Him, is the Great Creator and Merciful to His creation.
- I love my Family
- Surat Al-Kawthir
Applying the manners of recitation and memorizes Surah of Al-Kwther.

Supporting at Home

The support at home aims to document the student's relationship with the Holy Quran as the first source of knowledge, behavior, values, taste and beauty in order to build a Quranic mentality and psychology, by continuing to read the Qur'an and considering the provisions of intonation (*tajweed*).

One of the key elements of this support is to implant the love of Prophet Muhammad "peace be upon him" in the heart of the student through the experience of the Prophet's biography, and to highlight the life of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) as a good example and a role-model to follow.
