Homework

Each week the Year Leaders 1-6 will send out a homework schedule which clearly states the learning objectives in the main core areas of maths, science and English, that have been covered that week (example below is year 4). This is consolidation of work completed during the week and it will also provide revision examples for the term's assessment tests.
