Learning Theme

The children had a wonderful time last week, with our particular focus on the author Emily Gravett. This week we will look at another book, a modern classic called "The Tiger that Came to

Tea" by Judith Kerr. The story is about a girl called Sophie who sits down to tea with her mother one afternoon when the doorbell rings. A big, furry, stripy tiger has come for tea...and sandwiches, and buns, and biscuits...and eats all the food in the house until there's nothing left to cook for Daddy's supper. This book will serve as an introduction to our new learning theme of "Food Glorious Food". The children in Pre Nursery have loved our weekly cooking sessions this term so we plan to have a big focus on cooking, mixing, baking, icing... we are looking forward to plenty of investigating, exploring, discussion and of course – tasting!



Expressive arts and design

Children will be invited to access role play areas such as a shop, a kitchen and a restaurant, and engage in imaginative and make believe scenarios. There will also be plenty of opportunity to experiment with mixing and textures throughout the week, both in the role play kitchen, as well as during our food technology sessions.

Vocabulary: mix, lumpy, sticky, bake, cook, stir, taste

PSED and Communication and Language

There will be many opportunities to develop communication and language, as well as imaginative skills in our various role play areas. We will be holding a toys tea party, and also planning our very own tea party in the classroom when we will eat the delicious treats that we have prepared.

Vocabulary: Tea, party, buy, make, cook, food, eat, like, don't like
