

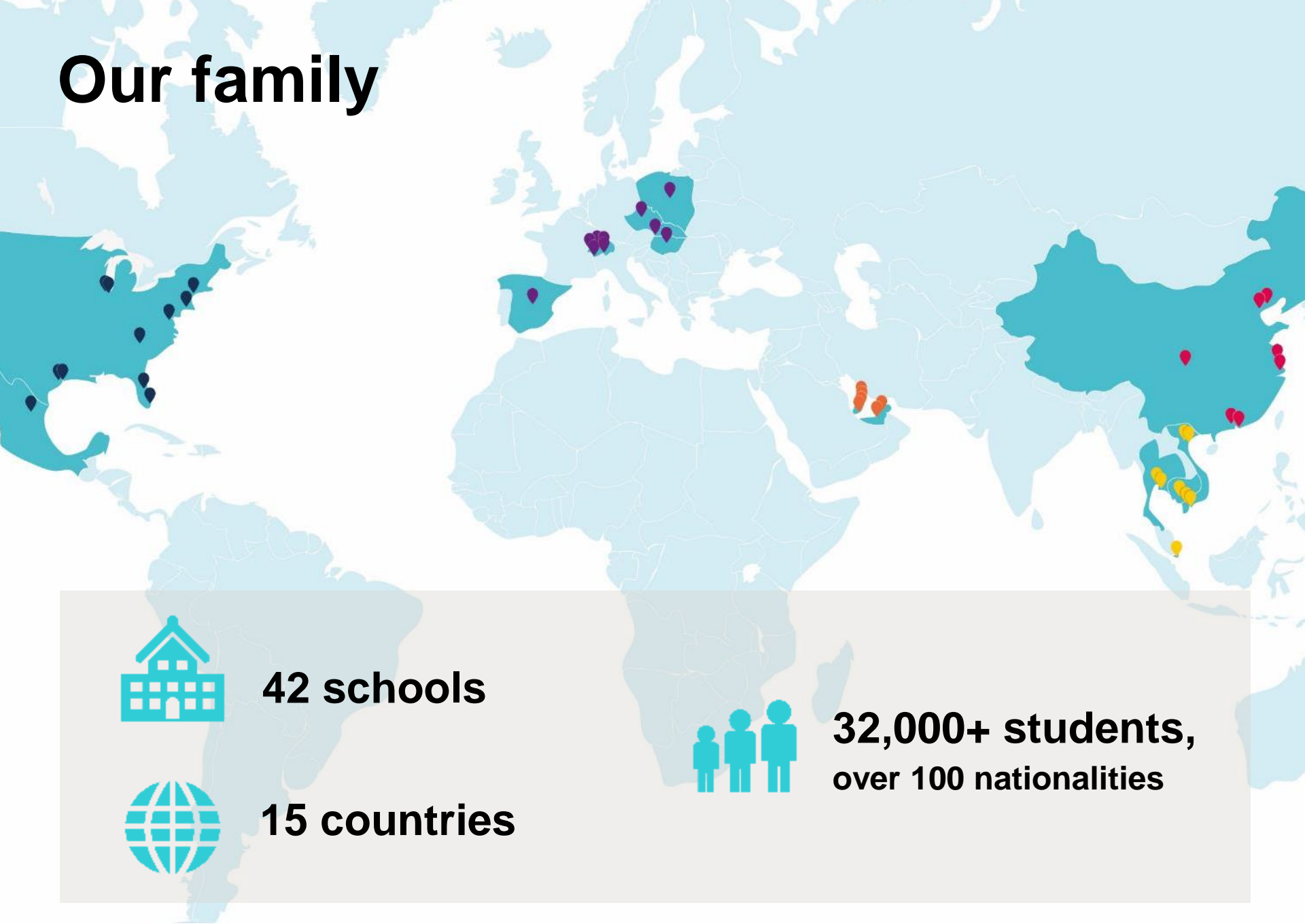

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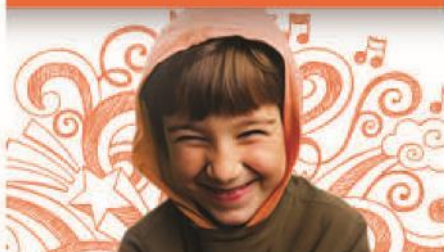

What areas will you find and how do they tie in to the curriculum?



Here you can explore English Language and Literacy, improve and learn new writing skills, and develop your knowledge and appreciation of English Literature. Activities include the Global Library, the Creative Writing Competition, writing workshops, and a celebration of 400 years of Shakespeare, plus more exciting things to come.



In this area you will be exploring many aspects of scientific discovery, such as conservation. It will also feature activities in Technology, Engineering and Maths. You will have the opportunity to learn more about coding throughout the year, to hone your computing skills.



This area will develop your knowledge and understanding of the world and the countries your fellow students come from. You will become a more active global citizen, test your geography skills, and dive into history from around the world, including that of your own family!

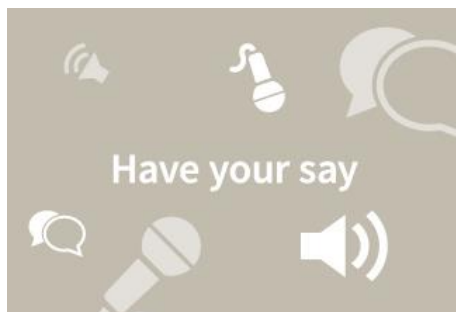

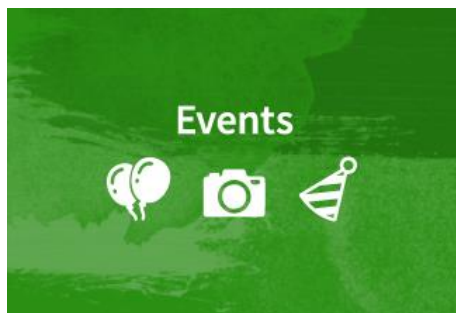

Check this area regularly throughout the year to see what's happening around our family of schools. Learn more about the next Global Event, and see what else is coming up that you can get involved with.

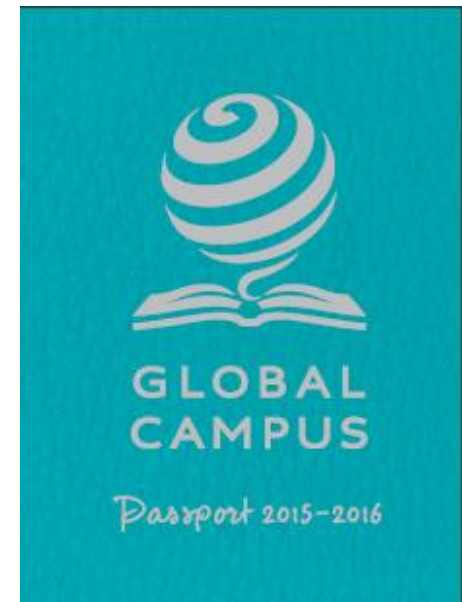

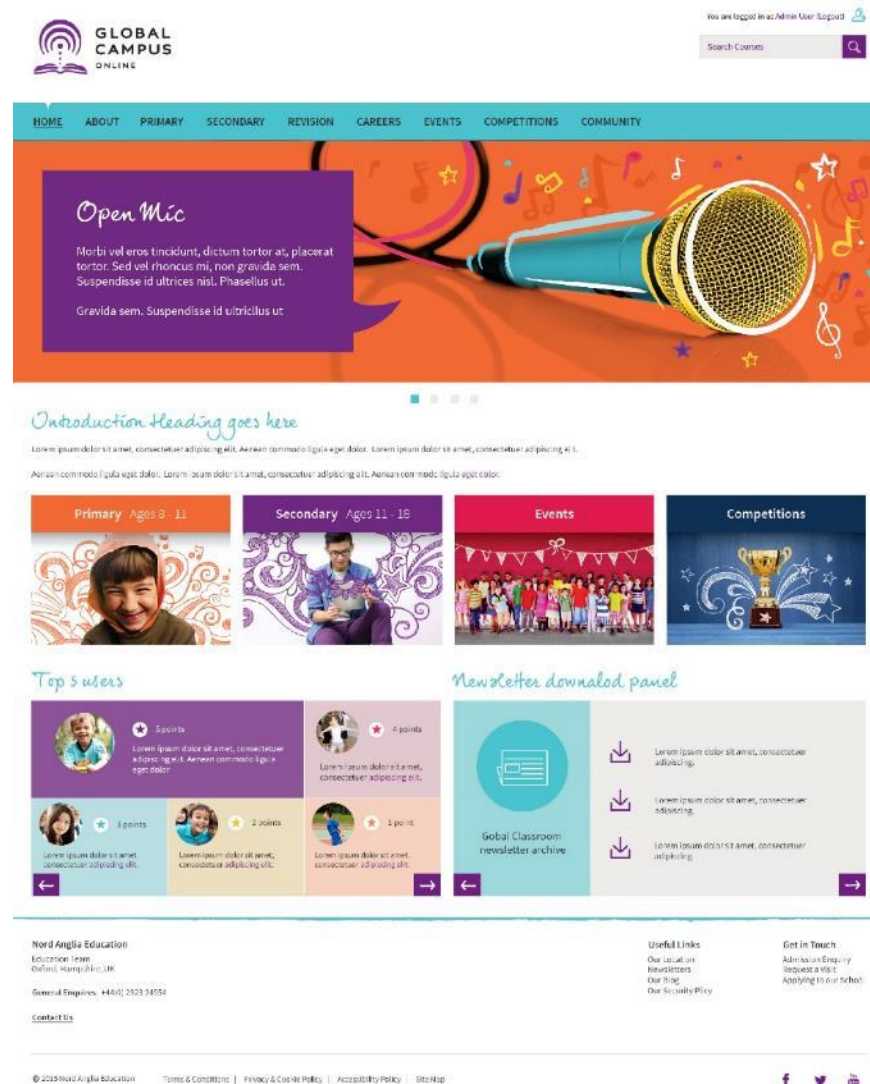
