Literacy

In Literacy the children will continue to read, discuss and analyse different genres of letters. They will investigate and collect examples of the language used for informal and

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formal letter writing. They will be using their research skills to help them find out "What is a Paleontologist?" and then through role play, explore the questions they might ask a Paleontologist and how they might respond. Finally the children will start to plan and draft a letter to a Paleontologist.

Maths

In Maths the children will be identifying and representing numbers, starting by grouping them into sets of 2s, 5s and 1os. Children will be learning to then represent their groupings as a number sentence using addition and multiplication. Finally they will be using these methods to help them estimate how many objects all together.

Themed Learning

Themed Learning covers our Science, Humanities and Art sessions. Teachers will be adopting a themed learning approach on a weekly or biweekly basis to allow for a more creative, cross-curricular approach to learning. Teachers may highlight specific Science, Humanities and Art skills being covered each week, but generally will provide an overview for the learning block.

'Footprints from the Past'

This week, the children will continue to focus on Humanities. The children will be using their research and note-taking skills to help them answer the question: *Who discorered dinosaurs*? They will use a range of different resources, including the real story of Mary Anning . The children will be working in teams to present the information they have found out, with a focus on speaking and listening.

PHSCE

The children will be continuing to focusing, as a year group on the topic of New Beginnings, with particular emphasis on fostering teamwork within the class and year group. The children will be involved in thinking about how we can work together inside and outside the classroom to make the school a happy environment for everyone.

Vocabulary

Literacy – letter, informal, formal, layout, structure, address, conclusion, paragraph, greeting, introduction.

Maths– figure, greater, bigger, larger, smaller, less than, between, order, digit, place value, thousands, hundreds, tens, units, number bond.

Themed Learning – paleontologist, fossil, discover, Jurassic, Triassic, Cretaceous **PSHCE** – beginnings, happy, safe, team, care, share, encourage
