Learning Theme of the week

Looking Forward

We will be talking to the children about what 'Looking Forward' means. We will recap things we have done, today, and think about things that are going to happen. We will consider both the near future (eg tomorrow) and the longer term future (eg moving to Reception). The children will be spending a short period of time in Reception and meeting some of the staff working in the unit.

Key Vocabulary: past, present, future, tomorrow, next year.

Some of the main learning intentions taught and explored this week will be:

Communication, Language and Literacy

Children will be invited to draw a picture of themselves, and encouraged to annotate it with their name and any other writing and mark making they wish.
Key Vocabulary: name, letter, write, shape, line, mark, space, meaning.

Mathematics

• We will be exploring shape through model building and construction kits. We will consider the most suitable shapes to use for different purposes, and how the properties of the shapes affect how we can use them.

Key Vocabulary, shape, 2 dimensional, 3 dimensional, side, corner, straght curved.

Expressive arts and design

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Children will continue to record through drawing and painting some of the experiences that they have had throughout the academic year. They will have the opportunity to enjoy printing, painting, colour mixing and collage activities. **Key Vocabulary.** Draw, picture, colour, paint, mix

Physical development

• Children will continue to enjoy challenging themselves using the outdoor equipment, as well as having their usual weekly PE and swimming lessons.

Personal Social and Emotional Behaviour

- We will be discussing in small groups about the move to Reception next year. Children will be encouraged to identify things that they would like to learn more about and do more of next year. If children have concerns or worries we will have an opportunity to discuss these too.,
- Key Vocabulary: next year, Reception, like, don't like, worried, excited

Mandarin

It is summer holiday soon.We are going to talk to children about their holiday. Children will talk to each other about where they are going to travel? What transports will they use? What are they going to do on holiday? In this topic, the children will learn some new phases but also review some previous knowledge.
