Starters: Reading



Listen to an audiobook of a story and talk about what you listened to with an adult or sibling.



Listen to an audiobook of a story and draw a picture of what happened in the story (Beginning, Middle, End).



Listen to an audiobook of a story and draw a picture of what happened in the story (Introduction, Build-up, Problem, Resolution, Ending).



Listen to an audiobook of a story and draw or write an alternative ending to the story. E.g. instead of the Gruffalo being scared of the mouse, did he chase the mouse and then catch and cook it?

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading 3 times a week and reading record signed
- Spellings
- Mathletics
- Reading Eggs
- Spelling City activities

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.
- Dessert projects are optional. If you have completed it, you will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
- If you are feeling *extra* hungry, you can order from the starters. Each dish has a difficulty rating. The more chillies, the more *challenging* the task!
