This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week.**

In *Literacy*, we will be revising how to check our work for full stops and capital letters, as well as learning about newspaper articles.

In *Numeracy*, we will be working on doubling and halving numbers. We will be finding a fraction of a shape too.

In *Science*, we will be finishing our unit on electricity and starting a new unit all about light and dark.

In IPC, we will be learning about different forms of communications and the inventions that help us to communicate.

In PSHE, we will be finishing our work on dreams and goals by creating our own dream garden to help us realise what we need to achieve their goals.

In ICT, we will be using google to search for information about famous people using skimming and scanning to find the relevant information.

For *Spellings*, please practise any words that have the following sounds in with your child. They will then be tested on 10 random words that have this sound in on Thursday to see how they are applying their phonics learning to spelling.

Mr Chad's group: 'or' as in fork, and 'ur' as in turn.

Ms Nadine's group: 'oa' as in boat.

Mr Spencer's group: 'air' as in fair.

Mrs Burgess' group: All of the Phase 3 sounds we have covered so far – Revision.

Ms Dianne's group: 'oi' as in boil, and 'ear' as in fear.

Ms Claire's group: 'a e' as in amaze, and 'u e' as in cube.

Ms Dipti's group: The following Year 2 tricky words – after, again, any, bath, beautiful, because, behind, both, break, busy.

Notice & Reminders:

- Please ensure your child arrives at 7:00am, ready to be lined up for 7:10am. If your child is late they are missing Phonics the lesson which teaches them how to read in English. This is an extremely important lesson for all students, but particularly for those with English as a second language.
- It is Assessment Week next week. The Numeracy Assessment is on Sunday and the Writing Assessment is on Monday. Please ensure your child is at school and on time.
