Starters: Reading



Ask an adult to read you a story and talk about the pictures.



Read a story book with an adult and ask your adult to ask you questions about the story.



Read a story book with an adult and write down questions for them to answer.



After reading a story, find words that you are not sure of and find them in the dictionary to understand the meaning.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading 3 times a week and reading record signed
- Spellings
- Mathematics
- Reading Eggs
- Spelling City activities

Dessert: Optional projects to be brought in on Sunday 3rd February
