This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will look at the difference between main clauses and subordinate clauses before using coordinating and subordinating conjunctions to start and extend sentences.

In **Numeracy**, we will be continuing our preparation for the upcoming Cambridge assessments by going over past papers from previous years. We will also be focusing on calculating the area of compound shapes.

In **Science**, we are revising forces, changes of state, electricity and food chains in preparation for the Cambridge Entry Exams.

Our **IPC** we are learning the process of how oil is formed and making interactive displays of the process. We are also learning to create maps of where oil is found, which will include symbols and keys.

In **ICT**, we will continue working on our Movie Maker projects to create a short video of our time in Year 6.

In **PSHE**, we will continue our topic of 'Healthy Me' by looking at our emotional health and well-being.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
