Learning Theme Ten Days of Chinese New Year!

The first week of our Chinese New Celebrations have kept us very busy. We have made stir fries, painted pictures inspired by Cherry Blossom, practised Chinese calligraphy, and learned about the story of The Great Race. Next week will be equally exciting as we move on to learning more about the ways in which people celebrate the Chinese New Year. We are looking forward to writing our wishes for the wishing tree; more Chinese inspired cookery sessions, and lots of dancing and music making.



Expressive Arts & Design:

We will learn about some of the dances that are associated with Chinese New Year. The children have begun to create dragon masks, and we will continue making these, before using them to perform our own dragon dance. We will also listen to the music that accompanies the Dragon Dance and the Lion Dance, and we practise using a range of instruments to create our own musical accompaniment.

Literacy:

We will look at pictures of wishing trees, and then introduce the children to our own wishing tree. We will talk about what a wishing tree is for, and think about things that we might wish for. The children will have the opportunity to write their own wishes, associating their mark making with a meaning, before hanging them onto our tree.

Next week we will focus on the topic of Chinese New Year. We will talk to the children about the Zodiac and that next year is the year of goat. We will be making lanterns and sweet rice balls in our celebrations and look at how others are celebrating Chinese New year around the World.
