### Messages

## Literacy

We will be continuing the genre of journalistic writing. The students will be identifying features of newspapers and applying these to create their own articles about 'water' based news events around the globe. They will include eye witness accounts and expert opinions and advice. The grammar focus of the week will include direct and reported speech; apostrophes for contractions and possession. The spelling rule of the week will be adding the suffix 'ing' to verbs.

### Maths

In our key skills lesson we will be developing abilities to solve multiplication and division problems. The main focus of the week will be examining the properties of shapes; in particular parallel and perpendicular lines. During problem solving students will develop the ability to solve word problems involving shapes.

### Themed Learning - Water

The students will be researching 'coasts' and will be asked to discover the meaning of associated vocabulary to these geographical features. They will be asked to complete a challenge to create a presentation to showcase their learning.
