Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) are an integral part of the education offered at BIS HCMC and provide our students with a broad range of learning opportunities which impact positively on many facets of their development, including academic progress. There is an extensive range of CCAs available to choose from each week at the BIS Secondary Campus with over one hundred different activities on offer. As we move into Term 2, we would like to challenge and encourage students to explore some of the exciting new activities being introduced. From our specialist external providers there are opportunities to join the Music Video Production Workshop, the Pottery Club, Archery as well as a Climbing Club. In addition to the many popular musical options continuing from last term, our Music Department will be offering a Drumming Circle for students interested in learning a variety of world drum rhythms. You may also want to look out for some fascinating new student-led activities such as The Improv Games where you can enjoy improvisational drama techniques or the Battle Bots Fight Club where you will have fun applying the fields of electronics, mechanics and programming to create robots using Arduino kits.

Whether you enjoy art, music, drama, sport, languages, solving mathematical or scientific problems, helping disadvantaged groups, competing in the Duke of Edinburgh International Award or just wanting to try something new, there should be a club available for you.

Please remember that if there is an activity you would like the school to consider introducing which is not already on offer, please contact Ms Brownrigg (Co-Curricular Coordinator) as she would be happy to see how this could be facilitated. You may even want to consider applying to lead an activity which is of particular interest to you – keep a look out for the Term 3 proposal invitation on Monday 4th March 2019.

Paid Activities

There are a number of paid activities that students can sign up for. All of the information regarding these is detailed in the online activities booklet. If a student has selected a paid activity, an email confirming their choice will be sent to both the student and their parents.

The payment deadline for all paid clubs is **Friday 11th January 2019**.

CCAs may run before lessons and during lunchtimes, however, the majority are scheduled after lessons. There are two sessions each afternoon with a five-minute change-over period (2:50pm – 3:50pm and 3:55pm – 4:55pm). If activities finish beyond these times information is detailed in the booklet.

Note: Any students participating in CCAs from 3:55pm will need to arrange their own transport home and should consider this before selection.

The aims of our Co-Curricular activities (CCAs) at BIS, HCMC are:

- To provide a wide range of enjoyable and challenging experiences above and beyond the timetabled curriculum
- To allow competitive teams, drama companies and music ensembles to reach high standards of team/group and personal performance
- To provide opportunities for students to aspire to elements of the school's mission statement
- To continue to develop our involvement in community work
- To offer a balance of endeavour which provides the framework for the IBDP CAS Programme

CAS at BIS

Creativity, Activity and Service are woven throughout the Co-Curricular Activities. Originating from the International Baccalaureate Programme they set out to challenge our students to show initiative and perseverance as well as to develop skills such as collaboration, problem solving and decision making. For a balanced experience, we encourage students to take part in at least one of each of the three areas below:

- Creativity: The arts, music, languages and other experiences that involve creative thinking.
- Activity: Physical exertion contributing to a healthy lifestyle.

- Service: Any collaborative and reciprocal community engagement in response to an authentic need.

Sporting Activities

This year, the PE and Sport department is trialling a new approach to the way in which competitive sport is structured. We will be moving to seasons of sports, as opposed to terms of sports, to fit in with the seasons of the SISAC competitions.

This will allow double training sessions throughout the week for our competitive teams and give the students an opportunity to participate in other activities once the City Championships have finished.

When in the off season, we will still provide one training session per week to prepare for the upcoming season in that sport. During the sports season, we would expect students who are committed to playing in the school teams to attend both training sessions in the week.

On-line CCA Selection – using CHQ

Activities need to be selected using the online CHQ system. Please see the next page for further instructions.

You will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line CHQ homepage. Both students and parents will receive notification when accepted for participation in a CCA.

For the majority of CCAs, the online system (CHQ) will randomly allocate students to each CCA. As it is not a first come first served system, you may not always get your first choice activity.

There are some exceptions to this rule as detailed below:

Sports

If the number of students for any sports activity is greater than the maximum capacity, students will undergo a trial and be notified of this during their first session. This may mean that you could initially be accepted for the CCA but possibly removed after the trial.

The PE department will endeavour to run a parallel programme during the same session for the same age group in the form of a recreational club. Therefore, if a student has a poor trial or significantly improves their skill level, the squad coach will be able to assess the student and potentially accept them into the squad at a later time.

Please note that:

- As competitive Sport will be moving to seasons and not terms (Sep - Nov, Nov - Feb, Feb - May and then May-June), some of the clubs advertised in September will stop in November and some of the clubs will start in November and span over into Term 2.

Drama

The *Little Shop of Horrors* cast will automatically be signed up to CHQ as rehearsals increase to Monday, Wednesday and Friday in Term 2.

Music

For any student interested in signing up for Chamber Choir or Chamber Orchestra, please see Mr Alexander to arrange an audition.

How to select your activities/paid clubs:

- **Step 1:** From the Home Page under **My Activities 2018-2019 Term 2** click **View/Manage/Submit Activity Choices**
- **Step 2:** For each activity/paid club add a different number e.g. Monday: Football club **add 1**, Wednesday: Board Games **add 2** then **3, 4, 5** etc. to all other clubs you would like to participate in.
- The **SAVE** button will appear to the right of the activity list click **SAVE**
- **Step 3:** Once you're happy with your choices you **MUST** press the **SUBMIT** button at the top of the page. You will receive an automated email confirming your club preferences.
- **Step 4:** To cancel a selection after submitting add a 0 to the desired box then save and submit
- **Step 5:** From the Home Page **My Activities 2018-2019 Term 2** you will be able to see which clubs you have been accepted into/denied from by Monday 7th January 2019. If you click onto **My Schedule** for week beginning Wednesday 23rd January 2019, you can check your weekly club timetable.
