

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be looking at features of a newspaper article, before writing our own. We will also be visiting the library.

In **Numeracy**, we will be looking at halves, quarters and mixed numbers. We will be learning about the x symbol and learning our 2, 5 and 10x tables.

In **Science**, we will be learning about the difference between light sources and reflectors and will be conducting an experiment to see if objects are sources of light or reflectors.

In **IPC**, we will be learning about maps and how we can record information on them. We will also be making our own telephones and using Morse code to send words and messages.

In **PSHE**, we will be starting puzzle piece 4, thinking about how we can keep our bodies healthy.

In **ICT**, students will be continuing their research about their famous person using google to find information.

For **Spellings**, please practise any words that have the following sounds in with your child. They will then be tested on 10 random words that have this sound in on Thursday to see how they are applying their phonics learning to spelling.

Mr Chad's group: 'oi' as in coin.

Ms Nadine's group: 'ur' as in turn.

Mr Spencer's group: 'ure' as in sure.

Mrs Burgess' group: All of the Phase 3 sounds we have covered so far – Revision.

Ms Dianne's group: 'air' as in hair and "ure' as in sure.

Ms Claire's group: 'u_e' as in tune, and how 'i' can make two different sounds like in tin and wild.

Ms Dipti's group: 10 Year 2 Tricky/High Frequency Words, as found in their communication book.
