We have several children at each phase of the school with severe nut allergies (life threatening) that can be triggered just by coming into contact with nuts or nut traces in foods. Can we please ask you to be very vigilant in ensuring that all foods that come into school, taken onto school buses, taken to school trips or sporting fixtures, are completely nut free. We thanks you for your support to ensure that all our students can be happy and healthy at school.

Literacy

This week the children will be continuing with focusing on the Just So Stories by Rudyard Kipling. Building on our work last week on settings and characters, the children will be choosing their own setting and character to describe. This will form the basis of their own Just So Story.

Maths

In Maths the children will be learning to recognise angles as a property of shape and associate angles with turning. They will be identifying right angles, recognise that two right angles make a half-turn, three make three quarters of a turn and four a complete

turn. Later in the week they will be identifying whether angles are greater than or less than a right angle.

Themed Learning

'Different Places, Similar Lives'

The children will be continuing their topic with a focus on Light and Shadows in Science. The children will be investigating the question "How can shadows be made bigger and smaller?" As part of this investigation, they will be measuring the length of the shadow in standard units (cm), making observations and using tables and bar graphs to record results.

PHSCE

In PSHCE we will be continuing to look at team work and collaborative working. We will focus further on working out how we can work together successfully, giving ideas and maintaining our focus and concentration.

Dutch
