Messages

- The FOBISIA maths challenge will be held at BISS Puxi on 5 and 6 March. All the children in Key Stage 1, 2 and 3 will be competing in their own maths challenge against all the other children in FOBISIA. Until 7 March, your child will be able to improve their maths knowledge, and practise for this challenge. All students have been given their log-in details for the Mathletics website, but please ask if they need a reminder.
- Over the next few weeks in Art we will be learning about African textiles and printing. If children wish to, they can bring into school an old item of clothing or a tea towel to tie dye on Monday 2nd March. Please choose a plain white/light coloured item. Thank you for your support with this.

Literacy

This week the children will be continuing to work on their speaking and listening skills. They will use their weather reports written last week to give well-structured descriptions and explanations of the weather. They will be challenged to speak audibly and fluently, and gain, maintain and monitor the interest of the listener. These will be recorded on video.

Maths

In Maths the children will be revisiting number. They will be challenged to use their knowledge of number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction to solve problems, including missing number problems.

Themed Learning

'Different Places, Similar Lives'

The children will be continuing to focus on Art, with this week's focus being textiles from Ghana in Africa. They will look at symbols used on Adinkra cloth and then

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experiment with creating printing blocks use press print or lino and cutting tools. After learning to dye material, they will use these blocks to create repeating patterns on their fabric. Finally the children will learn to use tie-dying techniques to dye material.

PHSCE

During their work on the textiles the children will be thinking about the lives of people living in other places and times and their national identity.

Vocabulary
